Ticket Allocation Notes

Each year it seems as though the number of tickets applied for increases, whilst the number of tickets we actually receive seems to decrease. This makes it increasingly frustrating for applicants and for the club as we try to keep members happy. The points below explain the procedure by which tickets are allocated within the club.

- Only current club members are eligible to apply for tickets. All applicants will be checked against 2010 database
- Preference will be given to those returning their application forms promptly
- Those adhering to guidelines (e.g. SAE) will have preference
- It is easier to allocate single tickets. Whilst every attempt is made to allocate pairs to those who request them, specifying that you only wish to receive a minimum of 2 tickets may count against you
- **Whilst every effort is made to allocate tickets at the requested price, occasionally it may be necessary to offer seats at a different price. It will be assumed that all those completing this form will be prepared to accept tickets at a higher or lower value if necessary**
- The club's management committee reserves the right to allocate a small number of tickets at its own discretion. Individuals allocated tickets in such a manner will be required to pay full price for such tickets.
- If you are able to provide an e-mail address this allows confirmation of receipt of your application and in the event of people wishing to return or exchange tickets, it provides a forum for this to take place. Your application will not be treated any differently if you do not wish to give an e-mail address.
- The club will retain a list of which member is allocated which ticket. Volunteer club members will check names against tickets at Twickenham on match day. By applying for tickets it is understood that you have no objection to this process. Refusal to comply on the day will affect your future applications. If you are prepared to help by checking tickets on the day please tick the box overleaf. Not volunteering to help the club in this way will not influence the ticket allocation procedure.
- If you are unable to use a ticket that has been allocated to you, you must notify Andy Bianchi immediately.
