Ticket Allocation Notes

Each year it seems as though the number of tickets applied for increases, whilst the number of tickets we actually receive seems to decrease. This makes it increasingly frustrating for applicants and for the club as we try to keep members happy. The points below explain the procedure by which tickets are allocated within the club.

- Only current club members are eligible to apply for tickets
- Every attempt will be made to ensure that each applicant sees at least one game
- **Preference will be given to those returning their application forms promptly**
- Those not allocated any tickets at last year's 6 Nations series will have preference
- Those adhering to guidelines (e.g. SAE) will have preference
- It is easier to allocate single tickets. Whilst every attempt is made to allocate pairs to those who request them, specifying that you only wish to receive a minimum of 2 tickets may count against you
- **Whilst every effort is made to allocate tickets at the requested price, occasionally it may be necessary to offer cheaper/more expensive seats. It will be assumed that all those completing this form will be prepared to accept tickets at a different value if necessary**
- The club's management committee reserves the right to allocate a small number of tickets at its own discretion. Individuals allocated tickets in such a manner will be required to pay full price for such tickets.
- Those wishing to travel to away matches are advised to seek tickets from other sources (with the possible exception of trips to the Mediterranean). The club's allocation for away games usually amounts to a maximum of 4 tickets per game.
- If you are able to provide an e-mail address this allows confirmation of receipt of your application and in the event of people wishing to return or exchange tickets, it provides a forum for this to take place. Your application will not be treated any differently if you do not wish to give an e-mail address.
- The RFU usually despatches tickets mid January
